- How did it affect the lives of the people?

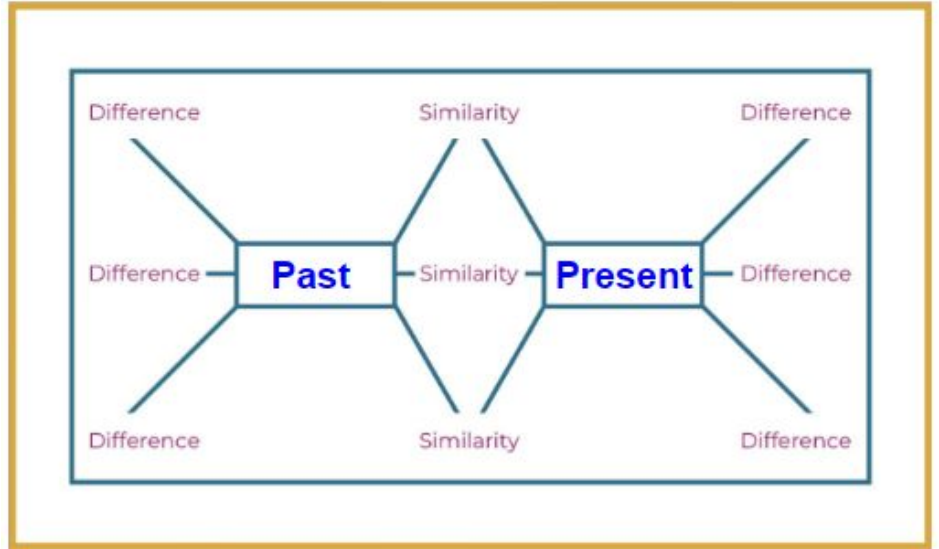


# Vocabulary

| <b>Artefact</b>  | An artifact is an object made by a human being, typically one of cultural or historical interest. |
| <b>Compare</b>   | Similarities and differences.   |
| <b>Different</b> | Not the same as another.  |
| <b>Evidence</b>  | A collection of facts or information showing if something is true or false.                       |
| <b>Past</b>      | The past talks about things that have happened.   |
| <b>Present</b>   | The present means something that is happening now.  |
| <b>Sequence</b>  | To arrange in a particular order.   |
| <b>Similar</b>   | When something is like something else, but not exactly the same.                                  |
| <b>Source</b>    | A source is a place, person, or thing from which something <b>originates</b> or can be obtained.  |
