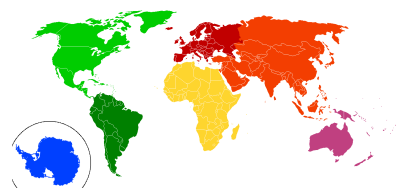

Music

As musicians we will...

- copy a simple rhythm using vocal sounds or percussion instruments.

Sing and perform a variety of songs.

Geography

As geographers we will...

- name and locate the seven continents and five oceans
- Name the four countries of the UK, their main characteristics and capital cities.

Use atlases and maps to find the continents and oceans.
Make flags, national flowers and taste regional food.

Science

As scientists we will...

- know that a wide range of creatures live in our oceans
- understand what floats and what sinks
- will understand the effect humans and pollution has on our oceans and sea life.
- learn about environmental scientists such as David Attenborough and Jacques Cousteau.

Name sea creatures and classify according to different criteria.

Experiment with a range of materials to see what floats and what sinks
Can we change the shape of materials to make them float or sink?

Look at the effect of single use plastics on our environment.
